7-1-17 Fee Letter to Businesses

A message from the Interim Director, Marie Woodin

Dear Business Owner:

The Environmental Management Department will not be raising fees this fiscal year (2017-18), with the exception of the spa program, where the fees are scheduled to increase incrementally over the next few years in order to recover those program inspection costs in full.

For businesses permitted under the Environmental Compliance Division, this will be the 7th straight year fees have remained the same. A fee study for this division will be undertaken this fiscal year and any fee changes will become effective in July, 2018. We will be holding public workshops and inviting public comments once the study has some findings.

Also this year, for some programs where fines and penalties have been collected that exceed EMD costs of enforcement, penalty money will be returned as credits against fees for those companies that are in compliance and are in those same programs. Almost a quarter of a million dollars has been credited to date.

My managers and staff are committed to utilizing the most efficient technology in order to contain or reduce program costs.
