		17.	Pool/spa are tested for disinfectant, pH and spa water temperature once per day.
		18.	Tiles are intact and in good repair and depth marker tiles are readable.
		19.	Pool shell with no or minimal chips/cracks.
		20.	There is 4 ft of unobstructed deck around the pool & lift.
		21.	Grab and hand rails tightly secured in place.
		22.	Spa emergency shut off switch shuts off spa booster and spa recirculation pumps.
