**Introduction**

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment for California Waste Recovery Systems.

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

California Waste Recovery Systems is a large volume transfer station located at 175 Enterprise Court in Galt, CA 9532 (APN 150-0011-075-0000). On Sept. 14, 2017, the LEA received an RFI Amendment application to amend the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR), as follows:

**Revisions to the facility's TPR include minor edits to clarify or address:**

- **Changes in the way recyclable materials residuals are to be managed**
- **Use of the portable sort line**
- **Outdoor bale storage measures**
- **Facility site maps updated to reflect current building layout and material flow patterns.**

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on October 10, 2017.
