Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Site Information (RFI) Amendment application for the South Area Transfer Station to revise the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR). The LEA is

certified by CalRecycle to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including transfer stations.

Description of project and LEA's determination

South Area Transfer Station is a large volume transfer station located at 8550 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento in Sacramento, CA 95826. On August 25, 2017, the LEA received a RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR in order to address a change of operations. The revisions (and the over-all RFI amendment) were approved by the LEA on September 14, 2017.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
