Notice to Amend the Report of Facility Information  
August 15, 2016

**Introduction**

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station.

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station is a large volume transfer station located at 8491 Fruitridge Rd in Sacramento, CA 95826 (APN 061-0173-028-0000). On August 10, 2016, the LEA received an application package to amend the RFI, as follows:

- Outdated site map was removed and replaced with an updated one.
- Sentence added to clarify as to when the maximum permitted daily tonnage can be exceeded during a declared public health emergency.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on August 15, 2016.
