**Introduction**

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA approved a RCSI amendment for Lopez Agricultural Services, LLC

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

Lopez Agricultural Services, Inc. is a green waste composting facility located at 11499 Florin Road, Sacramento, CA 95830 (APN 067-0120-069-0000). On August 17, 2016, the LEA received an application package to amend the RCSI, as follows:

- 1) Added Humus as a feedstock material.
- 2) The Gypsum pad area is to be improved to facilitate access during wet weather.
- 3) Table 2-3 Record keeping was added
- 4) Table 2-1 Feedstock was updated

- 5) Table 2-4 Acreage and Estimated Storage was updated
- 6) The Windrow temperature monitoring paragraph on page 2-18 was updated for clarification.
- 7) Code sections were updated to reflect code changes in 2016.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on August 17, 2016.
