Introduction

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for Elder Creek Recovery and Transfer Station.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Elder Creek Recovery and Transfer Station is a large volume transfer station located at 8642 Elder Creek Rd in Sacramento, CA 95828 (APN 064-0020-008-0000). On June 8, 2018, the LEA received an application package to amend the RFI, as follows:

- Section 3.1.5 of the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) was added to describe food and green waste operations.
- Site maps were revised for updated material stockpiling locations on the indoor and outdoor tipping pads.
- Update of general manager and operations manager information in Appendices A, C, and E.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on July 3, 2018.
