		A Small Quantity Generator (SQG) is a hazardous waste generator who generates less than 1000 kg (about 270 gallons) of hazardous waste per month.				
	<b>Contingency</b> A Contingency Plan is a written plan that specifies emergency actions and procedures to be undertaken in the event of an emergency at a facility.					
Exemption	A CESQG or an SQG is not required to prepare a full written Contingency Plan unless the facility stores regulatory threshold quantities of hazardous materials or hazardous waste at any one time (see the table below in <i>Who's eligible</i> ). However, a CESQG or SQG exempt from Contingency Plan requirements must still implement specific emergency response procedures described further below.
