

## COVID-19 Guidance for Residential Outdoor Sales (Yard/Garage Sales)

### Background:

COVID-19, also known as the novel coronavirus, is a respiratory illness that is spread through the air via respiratory droplets from an infected person or by touching contaminated surfaces.

Preventing the transmission of COVID-19 requires a combination of prevention measures including: physical distancing, wearing face coverings, sanitizing surfaces, and staying home when not feeling well. ***PLEASE NOTE: Physical distancing alone is insufficient to prevent transmission of COVID-19.***

### Requirements:

- Use safety equipment
  - a. Wear and encourage the use of face coverings
  - b. Use and provide hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol for customer use
  - c. Provide trash can for disposal of safety equipment
- Practice social distancing
  - a. Position posters that encourage customer social distancing in visible areas
  - b. Position tables 6 feet apart
  - c. Position tape on the ground to identify customer directional flow
  - d. Ask customers to stand 6 feet apart from other parties at all times
  - e. Limit the amount of attendees to 25
- Clean and disinfect throughout the day
  - a. Clean surfaces with a [disinfectant product](#) frequently and before beginning next day sales
  - b. Do not combine yard sales or mix personal property from multiple households
- When exchanging paper and coin money
  - a. Do not touch your face afterward
  - b. Ask customers to place cash on the counter rather than directly into your hand
  - c. Place money directly on the counter when providing change back to customers
  - d. Wipe counter between each customer at checkout
