A message from the Director, Marie Woodin

Dear Business Owner:

The Environmental Management Department (EMD) did not raise fees this past fiscal year (2018-19). For businesses permitted under the Environmental Compliance Division, this was the 8th straight year fees have remained unchanged. A fee study is being conducted for the Department in order to adopt its fee ordinance which comes up for renewal for the fiscal year 2020-2021. Once the fee study is completed and there are findings indicating a change in fees in any of the programs, the information will be conveyed by public workshops. The workshops also allow for public comment.

In past years, some programs where fines and penalties have been collected and exceeded EMD's costs of enforcement, the penalty money was returned as credits against fees for those businesses that are in compliance and are in those same programs. During this next fiscal year, there will be no credits given since the enforcement penalty money collected in FY 2018-2019 did not exceed EMD's costs of enforcement.

My managers and staff continue to be committed to utilizing the most efficient technology in order to contain or reduce program costs.
