

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

Regarding the pending revision to the L&D Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit

To be held: Wednesday, February 20, 2019, at 5:30 p.m. at the Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) 10590 Armstrong Ave, Suite A, Conference Room B, Mather, CA 95655

Background: L and D Landfill is a landfill that accepts primarily construction and demolition waste. The landfill's Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the site (34-AA-0020), issued by EMD on January 19, 2016, allows for a maximum landfill elevation of 97' MSL. On March 19, 2018, the operator submitted an application to EMD to revise the SWFP to allow the maximum elevation to be increased to 140' MSL. The facility's closure date would also be extended from June 2023 to October 2031. The application was accepted as incomplete on April 18, 2018, pending submittal of additional information by the operator and accepted it as complete and correct on October 15, 2018. The Operator waived statutory timelines for the LEA to process the application pending completion of CEQA.

Purpose of Meeting: To provide information to the public regarding the proposed, Revised Solid Waste Facility Permit, pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14CCR), Section 21660 et seq. Additional information will be provided regarding the environmental review, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), currently in progress.
