Introduction

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities.

Notice to Amend the Report of Facility Information

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Sacramento Recycling & Transfer Station.

Description of project and LEA's determination

The Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station (SRTS) is a large-volume transfer station and materials recovery facility (MRF) with a permitted capacity to receive 2,500 tons per day of non-hazardous municipal solid waste, green waste, C&D, food waste, and recyclables. SRTS is located 8491 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826 (APN 061-0173-028-0000).

On September 2, 2021, the LEA received an application package to amend the RFI to include the addition of three separate Fire Rovers to the fire suppression system and an updated site map to reflect the changes.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, pursuant to 27 CCR and 14 CCR, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.

The LEA accepted the application and approved the RFI amendment on September 29, 2021.
