Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the Florin Perkins Public Disposal Site MRF/LVTS to revise the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR). The LEA is

certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including transfer stations.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Florin Perkins Public Disposal Site MRF/LVTS is a large volume transfer station located at 4201 Florin Perkins Rd in Sacramento, CA 95826. On August 7, 2018, the LEA received a RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR in order to address deficiencies identified by the LEA during the 5-year review of the facility's permit that was completed on June 14, 2018. The revisions were accepted by the LEA on August 14, 2018.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
